Gift Aid Explained and Notes

As from 6th April 2000 the Gift Aid Scheme has allowed us to reclaim the tax you have already paid on any subscription, covenant or donation made to us.

This means that for every £1 you donate to us, the taxman will give us another 28p at no cost to you. The only condition is that you are a tax payer (includes capital gains tax)

Notes

1. You must pay an amount of income tax and or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax in the year (currently 28p for each £1 you give)
2. If you pay income tax at a higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
3. You can cancel your declaration at any time by notifying the charity.
4. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay income or capital gains tax, you must cancel your declaration.
5. Please notify the RSPCA Nottingham and Notts Branch if you change your name or address. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, ask the charity or ask your local tax office for a leaflet.
